The North Bay Growth & Innovation Forum seeks North Bay and Greater San Francisco Bay Area companies that emphasize qualities of uniqueness, innovation, and growth potential to apply to present at the Forum. The Forum targets start-up and/or second-stage companies working in one of five core clusters: clean technology, biomedical/biotechnology, advanced technology, health/wellness, or food/wine product development. This program has won regional, state and national awards for innovative entrepreneurial spirit. The event is a collaborative production of the City of Santa Rosa, the Santa Rosa Chamber of Commerce, and the North Bay Angels.

The October 2010 North Bay Growth & Innovation Forum is the ninth in a series that showcases about 150 CEOs, world-class business executives, service providers, angel and venture capital investors, and founders of standout emerging and second-stage companies. The Forum will feature a total of at least five high-quality company presentations for investors, along with poster presentations from at least 10 companies looking for advice, strategic partners or other resources.
