HUMBOLDT STREET BIKE BOULEVARD PROJECT

The City of Santa Rosa continues to explore opportunities that will provide residents with other transportation options rather than using a motor vehicle, such as bicycling, transit and walking.

The Department of Public Works is in the process of developing design options for a bike boulevard on Humboldt Street from Lewis Road to 5th Street as proposed in the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan.

The purpose of this meeting is to explain the project, describe the proposed design options and provide you and your neighbors with an opportunity to raise issues or express concerns about the project or a particular project component.

A Bike Boulevard can have the following characteristics:

- A roadway that has been modified as needed to enhance bicyclist's safety, comfort, and convenience. They are designed as places where bicycles and cars can equally share the road.
- A bike boulevard normally has low traffic volumes and low speeds.
- A bike boulevard is an alternative to busier arterial roads and typically runs parallel to the arterial road which can serve the needs of all ages and experience levels.
