



NOTICE OF COMMUNITY MEETING/PUBLIC HEARING

2009 – 2014 CONSOLIDATED PLAN

The City of Santa Rosa would like your input on how it plans to distribute federal housing and community development funds it will receive over the next five years. Each year the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides funding for housing and community development programs. To receive these funds, the City must complete a report called the Consolidated Plan.

Beginning on April 3, 2009, the Draft Consolidated Plan for 2009 through 2014 and the 2009/2010 Action Plan will be released for public comment. The plan will be available electronically on the City's website at www.srcity.org. A hard copy will be available at the Department of Economic Development and Housing located in the City Hall Annex at 90 Santa Rosa Avenue; the City Manager's Office located in City Hall, 100 Santa Rosa Avenue, Room 10; and the Main Branch of the Sonoma County Public Library located at 4th and E Streets.

A public hearing/meeting will be held as part of the Consolidated Plan process. The public hearing/meeting will present findings from the consolidated planning research process and allow the public to provide input. The hearing/meeting will take place as follows:
