

## Santa Rosa's Redevelopment Accomplishments

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The following capital improvements, some of which are among Santa Rosa's best known civic features, were built with the financial participation of the City's Redevelopment Agency.

- Prince Memorial Greenway and Olive Street Park
- Vineyard Creek Hotel and Conference Center at Grace Brothers brewery site, including redevelopment of a former Brownfield's site
- Fourth Street/Downtown: Streetscape improvements, landscaping, façade improvements, pedestrian malls, substantial building rehab and reconstruction after 1969 earthquake
- Old Courthouse Square Park
- Funding contribution to Old Courthouse Square Unification Study and design competition
- Sonoma Avenue Park
- Downtown Library, City Hall, State and Federal Buildings
- Downtown Linkages Program to connect east and west sides of Highway 101 downtown including a new underpass under Highway 101 at 6<sup>th</sup> Street
- Pedestrian corridor improvements between SR Plaza and Railroad Square along Fourth Street, and improvements along Third Street
- Downtown Promotion Program, including holiday promotions program and Tour of California international cycling event
- Downtown parking signs and garages
- Road improvements for West Avenue, Stony Point and Sebastopol Road
- Bus shelter installations and improvements
- Graffiti removal, outreach and education programs
- Funding of Neighborhood Revitalization Program (NRP), a City interdepartmental program focused on improving living conditions and empowering residents in particularly troubled neighborhoods to fight graffiti, solve landlord tenant disputes and ensure City code enforcement
