**5.1 Humboldt Street Bike Boulevard Pilot Project - Traffic Circle at McConnell Avenue**

BACKGROUND: At the June 17, 2010 meeting, the Board also passed a motion that supported retaining the traffic circle at McConnell Avenue and Humboldt Street and not re-instating the all way stop control at that intersection.

On July 15, 2010, the Board agreed to further discuss staff's proposal related to the intersection of McConnell Avenue and Humboldt Street at their meeting in August.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board may, by motion, support staff's recommendation to remove the traffic circle at McConnell Avenue and Humboldt Street and re-instate all way stop control at McConnell Avenue and Humboldt Street.
