

Landscape Irrigation Audits



What is a landscape Irrigation Audit?

A landscape irrigation audit is an on-site review of the landscape plantings and outdoor irrigation water use. The irrigation audit will be performed by City of Santa Rosa Water Use Efficiency staff who are professionally certified as landscape irrigation auditors.

The irrigation audit will include an inspection of the irrigation controller and hardware, a determination of the landscape's watering needs, and a review of the current irrigation schedule. For dedicated irrigation meters, a water use analysis will be provided at the audit that compares water use over multiple years, compares water use to actual site budget, and shows cost savings that could be accomplished by using efficient irrigation hardware and techniques.

What Do I Get From a Landscape Irrigation Audit?

A report with findings regarding current water use and suggestions on how the customer can improve the site's irrigation water use efficiency, eligibility for City of Santa Rosa rebate or incentive programs, and other educational materials.
