Many activities happen along the 4th Street corridor at Railroad Square, Courthouse Square, and nearby venues including The Sonoma County Museum on 7th St. There are also several businesses on 5th Street participating. The Sonoma County Arts Council is now in their new space at 404 Mendocino Avenue, just north of 5th St.

Rosie The Trolley offers fun free transportation between venues and will run continuously from 5:00-8:00 p.m. Look on the map for Rosie Stops.

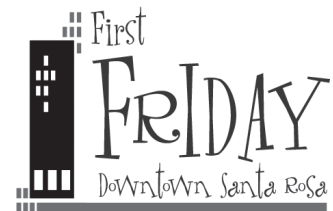

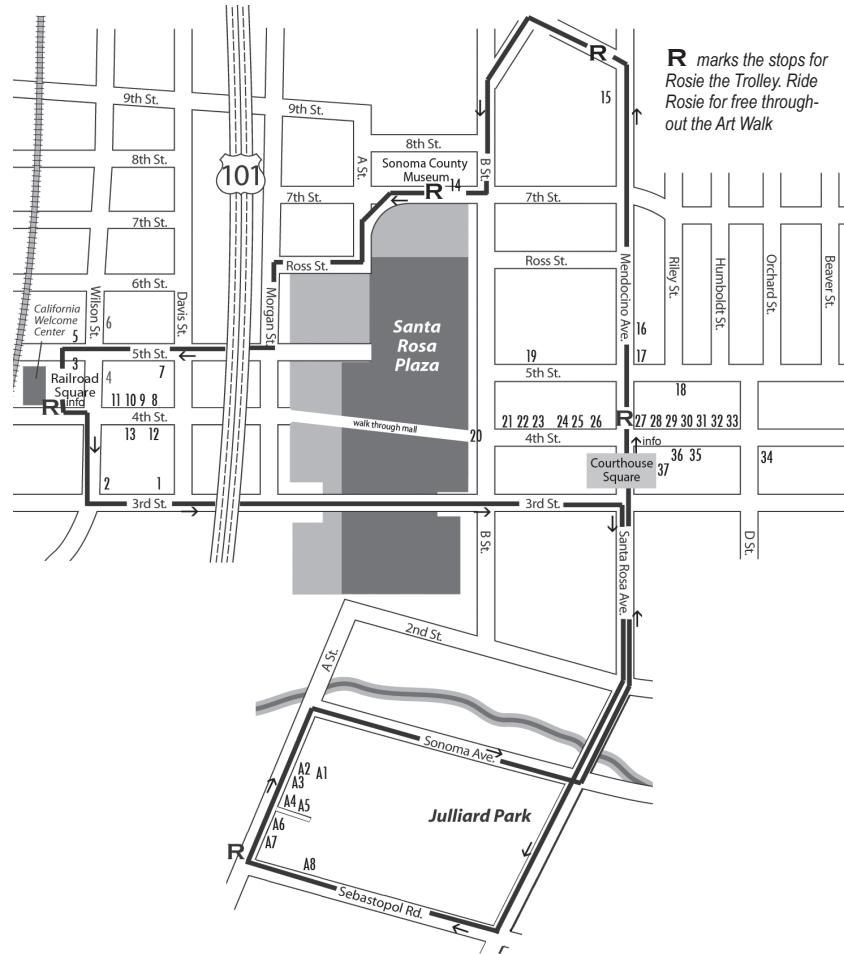
