A TWO-WHEELED CAR?

In many ways a bicycle is like a 2-wheeled car. Many of the rules of the road apply to bicyclists as well as drivers.

KEEP TO THE RIGHT

Bicyclists should ride in the same direction as traffic. The slowest traffic keeps farthest to the right. As a bicyclist, you should stop at signs and signals, and yield to pedestrians.

WEAR A HELMET

Always wear a helmet while riding. Make sure that it fits correctly and you wear it properly.

BE VISIBLE

When it's dark outside, make sure you can be seen. Wear light colored clothing and equip your bicycle with reflectors and lights if you ride in low light or at night.

SIDEWALKS

Riding your bicycle on a sidewalk is illegal in some areas. Riding in the street and obeying traffic laws can be safer than riding on a sidewalk.

DRIVERS

Most drivers are alert, but **don't assume** they have seen you.
