

What's Up With Downtown Parking?

The City is installing new lighting and painting the public parking garages with light-colored paint to make the garages bright and cheery at night.

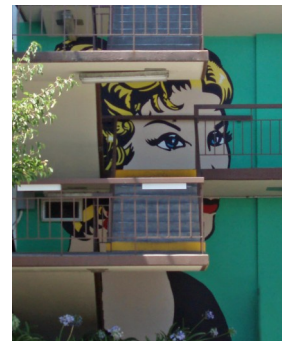


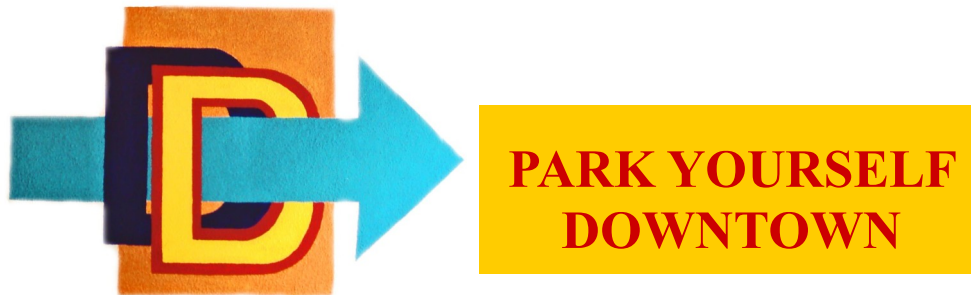
PUBLIC ART

The City has commissioned ArtStart, an arts training program for youth, to bring a sassy new look to three parking garages in Downtown. We're showing a few samples here, but be sure to look for the rest of the artwork near the pay stations and entrances at Garage 5 (3rd and D St.), Garage 9 (D St.) and Garage 12 (1st St.).

HERE TO LEND A HAND

Each parking garage is staffed by Parking Operations Aides, who monitor activities in the garage, assist with the new pay-on-foot stations, and escort patrons to their cars, if desired. To contact the Aide, use the call buttons located at the pay station or the vehicle entrance and exits. In addition, security guards patrol the City lots and garages 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.





TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES

The City is launching a pilot program to replace individual parking meters with pay stations in some of the surface lots and on part of 4th Street.

- A pay station will replace several meters, resulting in a tidier streetscape.
- You will have the ability to pay by currency and credit card (no more searching for quarters!), and receive a receipt for payment.
- The possibilities of adding time at any pay station or paying by cell phone are being investigated.
