

DOWNTOWN SANTA ROSA PUZZLE HUNT -- 2008

-- INTRODUCTION --

NOTE: This is a reprint of the questions for the event held April 5, 2008. Some minor edits have been made in the instructions to clarify a couple of common questions. Over time, some changes may occur to the downtown that could affect the answers.

This Puzzle has two parts.

1) Consider each haiku a question. Some are statements describing a place, others ask for a specific piece of information. See the sample below for how to complete these.

2) Answers to questions 1-16 are related, your task is to figure out how. That's the metapuzzle.

For numbers 1-15, a question posed in each should yield an answer listed on the attached answer sheet. Write in the locations as you find them so we know you've actually been there, then find the missing piece of information on the answer sheet and write in the corresponding number. You must do both to receive credit for the question.

For Question 16 and the metapuzzle you do not need to use the answer sheet.

For questions asking for an address, write in the street address but note that on the answer sheet only the street **number** is listed, not the name of the street.

Here's a sample for questions 1-15:

Explanation:

In Olive Park, just south of Railroad Square and the Prince Greenway there is a set of playground equipment shaped like a boat. Two springy dolphin rides are just to the boat's left. To the right is a small enclosure with a couple of child seats and the words "Club House" above the door. Find the word "House" on the list and write in the corresponding number: 153
