

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA

APPLICATION FOR DESIGN REVIEW APPROVAL FOR MUSEUM ON THE SQUARE, LOCATED AT 520 THIRD STREET

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the Redevelopment Agency on **Thursday, September 2, 2010 at or after 5:00 p.m.**, in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 100 Santa Rosa Avenue, Santa Rosa. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the Redevelopment Agency acting on the requested Design Review Approval for the proposed Museum on the Square project. The project proposes to adapt and re-use the existing five-story building for museum, restaurant, office, other commercial, driveway and parking purposes; utilize the rear of the site for residential parking, deliveries and access to basement parking; and add five additional floors for 43 residential units and a common terrace.

The application has been filed by Hugh Futrell Corporation. Said application and applicable information are on file and available for public inspection, and, upon the payment of the costs of reproduction, obtain copies of the application materials and any other information pertaining thereto, at the Department of Economic Development and Housing, City Hall Annex, 90 Santa Rosa Avenue, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, File No. SRC-N15; and on the City of Santa Rosa website srcity.org/att.
