JUNE 24 - CARNIVAL

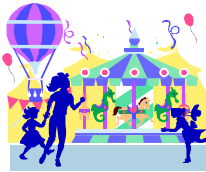
Howarth Park; 630 Summerfield Road

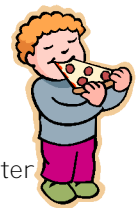
