

RESOLUTION NUMBER 174

A RESOLUTION OF THE CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA RECOMMENDING TO CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CHERRY STREET NEIGHBORHOOD HISTORIC DISTRICT AND ADDING 444 AND 446 ORCHARD STREET TO THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Santa Rosa did approve Resolution No. 20725 creating the Cherry Street Neighborhood Historic District on March 24th 1992; and

WHEREAS, the property owners at 444 and 446 Orchard have petitioned the Cultural Heritage Board about being added to the Cherry Street Neighborhood Historic District; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Heritage Board did hold a duly noticed public hearing to consider the architecture and history of the proposed properties and that of the district and all relevant information presented to the Board by staff and property owners of the proposed project and neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration the Cultural Heritage Board does find that the proposed properties are consistent with the City's General Plan, the requirements of the Historic and Cultural Preservation Ordinance and would be consistent with and add to the quality of the Cherry Street Neighborhood Historic District.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cultural Heritage Board of the City of Santa Rosa does hereby recommend to the City Council that the boundary of the Cherry Street Neighborhood Historic District be changed and the properties at 444 and 446 Orchard Street be added to the District.


