

RESOLUTION NUMBER 194

RESOLUTION OF THE CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A LANDMARK ALTERATION PERMIT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED WINDOWS AT 306 MENDOCINO AVENUE; ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBER 009-011-002, FILE NUMBER LMA05-018

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2005 the Cultural Heritage Board of the City of Santa Rosa considered the request, at which time it received written and oral reports of staff, testimony, and other evidence presented by all those who wished to be heard on the matter; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Heritage Board of the City of Santa Rosa, after due consideration, investigation and study made by itself and in its behalf, and after due consideration of all evidence and reports offered at said hearing, does find and determine the following:

1. The modifications are compatible with the building and have a minimal impact on the historic resource.
2. The window additions and changes retain or reflect the same or similar configuration and have been designed appropriately for the Rosenberg Building.
3. The almond vinyl coloration is compatible given the paint scheme that was presented to the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Cultural Heritage Board of the City of Santa Rosa does hereby approve the Landmark Alteration request subject to the following conditions:

1. Obtain a building permit.
2. Plans submitted for building permit shall be consistent with plans reviewed and approved by the Cultural Heritage Board on June 15, 2005.


