## 2008-2009 ACTION PLAN FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AND HOME FUNDS AND AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE 2004-2009 CONSOLIDATED PLAN

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday, May 6, 2008, at or after 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, 100 Santa Rosa Avenue, Santa Rosa. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on the FY 2008-2009 Action Plan and Amendment No. 2 to the 2004-2009 Consolidated Plan.

The Action Plan is the annual plan detailing Housing Authority and homeless related programs that the City of Santa Rosa will undertake to address the housing and community development needs and local objectives with funds to be received during the upcoming program year from CDBG, HOME, other HUD programs, and anticipated Program Income. Amendment No. 2 to the 2004-2009 Consolidated Plan is to include Public Facilities and Improvements as a Strategic Goal.

Copies of the 2008-2009 Action Plan and Amendment No. 2 to the 2004-2009 Consolidated Plan are available for public review and comment from March 31, 2008 to May 1, 2008 in the City Manager's Office, Room 10, City Hall, 100 Santa Rosa Avenue; the Department of Economic Development and Housing, City Hall Annex, 90 Santa Rosa Avenue; the Main Branch of the Sonoma County Public Library, 4th and E Streets; and on the City's website at [www.srcity.org](http://www.srcity.org).
