6.1 Street Performer Permit Program

Staff has become aware of a petition being circulated to overturn the City's noise ordinance because of its perceived conflict with expressions of art. The individual circulating the petition has been contacted and informed the City is in the process of developing a "Street Performer Permit Program" and inviting his input. Staff will present the outline of the proposed program to the committee.

**Recommendation:** Review and comment on proposed Arts District Street Performer program.

6.2 Nissan Public Art Project

Pursuant to payment of art in lieu fees, representatives from Nissan addressed the Committee to request the City facilitate a call for artists to place art in the median on South Santa Rosa Avenue and South A Street. Staff has been working with Nissan to work out details of their total art contribution, the criteria for the art piece and the timeline for the project.
