6.1 Mural Proposal for the Burbank Gardens Neighborhood

6.2 Modification of Water Features at City Hall

The two water features located at City Hall are aging, requiring increased maintenance costs as well as being features which require electricity and water to operate. One of the features has developed a large underground water leak and the other has a pump which needs replacement or removal. Both water features require modification to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility requirements. With the current economic climate and greater awareness of water and electric conservation, staff will recommend alternate uses for the two areas where the fountains are now located.

Recommended action: information, discussion and potential fountain sculpture re-use.
