5.1 Humboldt Street Bike Boulevard Pilot Project

BACKGROUND: On December 15, 2009, the City Council directed staff to discuss the proposed vehicle movement prohibitions at College Avenue and Humboldt Street and at Pacific Avenue and Humboldt Street as part of the Humboldt Street Bike Boulevard Pilot Project with the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board (BPAB).

On February 4, 2010, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board (BPAB) held a special study session to discuss proposed vehicle movement prohibitions at College Avenue and Humboldt Street and at Pacific Avenue and Humboldt Street. Staff presented information on the design proposal, impacts and concerns including potential impacts to emergency response time.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board may, by motion, support staff's recommendation to not implement the Vehicle Movement Prohibitions at College Avenue and Humboldt Street and at Pacific Avenue and Humboldt Street at this time.

5.2 Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan (BPMP) Update
