6.1 Peter Springs Park Mural

The Neighborhood Association of Bennett Valley has received a CAB grant for a mural project at Peter Springs Park. The project is planned using all volunteers and artists from Montgomery and Slater Schools. A representative of the Association will present the project to the Art Committee. Recommended action: discussion and review of proposed artwork design.

6.2 Process for Initiating Public Murals

Due to the increasing number of requests for murals in Santa Rosa, staff has developed steps to initiate those projects. Since many of the projects receive grant funding from a variety of community groups, it is important to share these recommended steps with groups such as the Community Advisory Board, Community Foundation Sonoma County, ArtStart and others. Recommended action: review mural proposal process and direct staff to disseminate mural process information to the community, including a formal presentation to the Community Advisory Board.
