5.1 Bicycle Transportation Account

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Transportation has issued a call for projects for the Bicycle Transportation Account (BTA) Program funding. Applications are due March 18, 2011.

The Public Works Department is preparing an application requesting funds to construct a Multi Use Path along the SMART corridor between College Avenue and Jennings Avenue.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board, by motion, may support the Public Works recommendation and issue a letter of support for the Bicycle Transportation Account application.

5.2 Proposed bike route destination signing

BACKGROUND: In February 2011, staff brought forth the concept of bicycle destination signing to the Bike and Pedestrian Advisory Board (BPAB). Staff reviewed some proposed routes and informed the Board that they would return with some signing options and would ask for their input on the design on the sign.

Since then, staff has developed three options for the Board to consider.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff is seeking Board input on their preference to which sign they would like used for the bicycle destination signing project
